

Internet restrictions

Access to websites with content that is pornographic, violent or against human rights, is strictly prohibited.

Anyone who fails to comply with this rule will be suspended from accessing the internet.

Modena municipal library members can access the online website **emilib.it** which offers free daily newspapers and magazines in all languages, music, videos, audiobooks and e-books.

To access the service, you need to:

- select 'Provincia di Modena' (Modena Province) in the field ENTE (organisation)
- at the bottom, click on 'BM BiblioMo. Polo Bibliotecario Modenese SBN' and then on 'BM BiblioMo'
- enter your Username (the code on your library card) and Password (the first time you access the website, the password is your date of birth in the format dd/mm/yyyy)

Admission free

In the library you can read and borrow all sorts of books for all age groups. You can also read magazines and daily newspapers, and surf the internet. You can study, search our catalogue, take part in events and meetings. In addition, there are foreign-language books and magazines, plus Italian and other language courses.

Children and teenagers

The library has special sections for children and teenagers, with books and videos suited to their age groups. The Delfini Library also has a **Baby Space** for little ones aged 0 to 3 years, and a **Pit Stop** zone for breastfeeding, which is also equipped with a baby changing station.

Joining the library

Joining the library is free and allows you to:

- borrow books and magazines, DVDs, music CDs
- watch films (only at the Delfini Library)
- listen to music (only at the Delfini Library)
- surf the internet
- write texts on a computer, save them on a usb flash drive and print them



Documents required to join the library

To join the library, you must present one of the following documents:

- identity card
- passport
- driving license
- valid residence permit

Library membership card

Membership cards are personal, have no expiry date and can be used in all the municipal libraries. Those under 16 years of age must have authorisation from a parent or legal guardian.

Borrowing

You can borrow up to 10 items at any one time, including a maximum of 3 music CDs and a maximum of 2 DVDs. Book loans last 30 days, while CD and DVD loans are for 7 days.

Self-service loan (only Delfini Library)

The self-service loan stations let you borrow and return up to 10 items at a time, check



reservations, extend a loan, print a reminder of transactions made.

Borrowing suspension

Your borrowing rights may be suspended if you are more than 30 days late in returning items borrowed. The suspension will be lifted upon return of the items and payment of a fine of 13 euros.

For lost or damaged books, CDs or DVDs, please contact the librarians.

Surfing the internet

In the library you can surf the internet using:

- your mobile phone, pc or tablet by connecting to the Modena WiFi service (unrestricted, free and without time limitations)
- internet stations for 1 hour per day (as long as you are an enrolled library member, you can simply show a valid I.D. document and log in using the log-in details provided by the library)

Teenagers aged 16 to 18 years of age can surf the Internet as long as they have authorisation from a parent or legal guardian; children up to 14 years of age can only access websites selected by the librarians.
